2024 RULES AND REGULATIONS – COMMERCIAL EXHIBITS AND CONCESSIONS

- 1. **LIABILITY:** While all precautions will be taken to guard against loss/damage of equipment or display material, the Lansdowne Agricultural Society will not assume any responsibility for losses/damages which might be incurred from pilfering, water damage, fire, accident, or any other cause.
- INSURANCE: Vendors must insure their goods and/or equipment against such loss. Vendors must carry a minimum of \$2 Million of liability insurance and must provide proof of insurance prior to the event.
- NO SUBLETS: Vendors may not under any circumstances sublet all or any portion of their booth or space rented under the terms of the contract.
- TYPE OF OPERATION: Vendors may not operate in any other business or sale of goods other than what is listed on the contract. Society reserves the right to demand the removal of any item(s) offered for sale or any operation that was not clearly approved or understood under "Type of Operation" on the contract.
- 5. SOUND/VIDEO: In cases where Sound and/or Video Equipment is used, the Vendor must receive approval from Lansdowne Agricultural Society to ensure that disturbance to neighbouring Exhibitors is minimal.
- 6. NO PAINTING of any kind may take place on the exhibition grounds without direct permission of the Lansdowne Agricultural Society.
- THERE WILL BE NO SALE OF DRAW TICKETS on the grounds without written permission of the Lansdowne Agricultural Society. (Free draws must be approved by the Lansdowne Agricultural Society before tickets are made available. Draws must be made by 4:00 p.m. Sunday). In all cases, a list of all winners and prizes awarded must be filed with the Exhibition Office before leaving the grounds.
- **DECISIONS:** Should any questions arise not provided for in the Rules and Regulations of the contract, the decision of the Board of Directors shall be final.
- FOOD VENDORS: No discharge of gray water on the ground. Holding tanks only. No glass bottles allowed for beverages. Fire extinguishers must be supplied and present in food booths at all times.
- 10. **REFUSE**: All refuse must be placed in the bins as directed by the Lansdowne Agricultural Society.
- 11. **DAMAGES:** The Vendor shall be responsible for all damages to or loss of Exhibition property, which results from the signing of the contract.
- 12. LOCATION: The Exhibition reserves the right to locate, relocate or alter the space assigned. No Vendor has the automatic right to occupy the same space in subsequent years.
- 13. CANCELLATION: The Lansdowne Agricultural Society reserves the right to cancel this agreement at any time, if, in its opinion, the terms and conditions of the contract are not being observed. In the event that the Vendor does not occupy space as contracted, the Lansdowne Agricultural Society is not required to refund any amount paid to date. If for any reason it is necessary to cancel this contract, the Lansdowne Agricultural Society must be notified 30 days prior to the opening of the Fair or the total amount will be assessed.
- 14. VENDOR PASSES: Vendors must purchase one vendor's pass/wristband at the cost of \$10.00, which will allow the vehicle and driver to enter the grounds. Only one additional vendor's pass/wristband may be purchased for \$10.00. Parking will be in a designated area only. Vendors will be required to wear a weekend wristband for easy entry to the arounds.
- 15. **VENDOR VEHICLE PARKING:** To park a vehicle beside your concession booth, there will be a charge of \$50.00. A parking permit will be issued, and payment collected at the discretion of the Lansdowne Agricultural Society. The license plate number of the vehicle must be recorded on this permit and then be displayed on the dash of the vehicle.
- 16. HYDRO: Standard electrical outlets will be available. It is the responsibility of the vendor to ensure that their equipment and/or connections are CSA/ESA approved and in good condition. Any necessary permits or inspections are the responsibility of the vendor.

These rules and regulations shall be enforced for all commercial exhibitors and concessionaires, and therefore this document becomes part of the contract between each exhibitor/vendor and the Lansdowne Agricultural Society.
